## OFFICIALS' CODE OF CONDUCT

## As an Official, I state that I will:

- Not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any player, coach, parent, official or any other attendee.
- Not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well-being of any player, coach, parent, official or any attendee.
- Not engage in the use of profanity.
- Treat any player, coach, parent, official or any attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
- Work with the other officials and staff in a constructive and cooperative manner.
- Avoid the use of alcohol and tobacco products during the contest.
- Dress neatly and appropriately.
- Be punctual and professional.
- Will constantly remain of the inherit risk of injury that competition poses to the athletes.
- Maintain a professional approach and not engage in activity involving the contest, my fellow employees and the City of Paris involving Social Media.
- Make every attempt to understand the rules of the game.
- Resist every temptation and outside pressure to use my position as an official to benefit myself.
- Avoid promoting special interest of any person or group of persons other than the athletes themselves.

Every member of the officiating crew carries a responsibility to act in a manner becoming a professional person. The conduct of myself and other officials is a direct reflection and attitude of the public towards myself and the City of Paris.

I understand that my failure in following this Code of Conduct could result in disciplinary action, including, but not limited to the termination of my job.
