4-201. Plumbing Code Adopted. Pursuant to the authority granted by T.C.A. 6-54-501 et seq. and for the purpose of regulating plumbing installations, including alterations, repairs, equipment, appliances, fixtures, fittings, and appurtenances thereto, within or without the municipality when such plumbing is or is to be connected with the municipal water or sewerage system, the 2012 International Plumbing Code with all current amendments is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as a part of this code and is hereinafter referred to as the "Plumbing Code". (Ord. #679, 03/03/88; Ord. #738, 08/17/90; Ord. #864, 10/06/94; Ord. #934, 06/02/98; Ord. #1063, 9/7/06; Ord. #1082, 2/7/08, Ord. # 1135, 04/05/12).

4-202. <u>Modifications</u>. The plumbing code adopted and incorporated by reference in 4-201 is amended as follows:

- A. Any provisions of the plumbing code which are inconsistent with or in conflict with the express provisions found elsewhere in the Paris Municipal Code are hereby deleted.
- B. The "plumbing official" or "inspector" as provided in the plumbing code shall be the building inspector of the City of Paris or such person as the city manager shall designate to administer and enforce the provisions of the plumbing code.
- C. A single facility consisting of one water closet and one lavatory may be used by both male and female in the following occupancies subject to the building area limitations:

4-203. Available in recorder's office. Pursuant to the requirements of Section 6-621 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, three (3) copies of the plumbing code with the above modifications have been placed on file in the recorder's office and shall be kept there for the use and inspection of the public.

4-204. <u>Violation.</u> It shall be unlawful for any person to violate or fail to comply with any provision of the plumbing code as herein adopted by reference and modified. (Ord. 1063, 09/07/06)
